Short Catechism lessons

368. How do we sin against faith?

We sin against faith:

- 1) when we wilfully doubt any revealed truth;
- 2) when we refuse to believe what God teaches us by his Church:
- 3) when we are ashamed to pass for a Christian, or when we formally deny our faith;
- 4) when we neglect to learn sufficiently the Christian doctrine.

369. Who are they who refuse to believe what God teaches by his Church?

Heretics and infidels are they who refuse to believe what God teaches by his Church.

370. Is it a great fault not to openly profess our Faith in the true Church in which we inwardly believe?

Yes, it is a great fault not to openly profess our faith in the true Church when we inwardly believe in it, because Our Lord has said: Whosoever shall deny me before men, I will also deny him before my Father, who is in heaven.

371. Are we often obliged to make open profession of our faith?

Yes, we are obliged to make open profession of our faith as often as God's honor, our neighbour's spiritual good, or our own requires it : Whosoever, says Christ, shall confess Me before men, I will also confess him before my Father, who is in heaven.

372. Which are the sins against hope?

The sins against hope are Presumption and Despair.

373. What is Presumption?

Presumption is a rash expectation of salvation through which we rely on God's mercy as a license to commit sin and to delay our conversion.

374. What is Despair?

Despair is the loss of hope in God's mercy regarding our conversion and eternal salvation.
