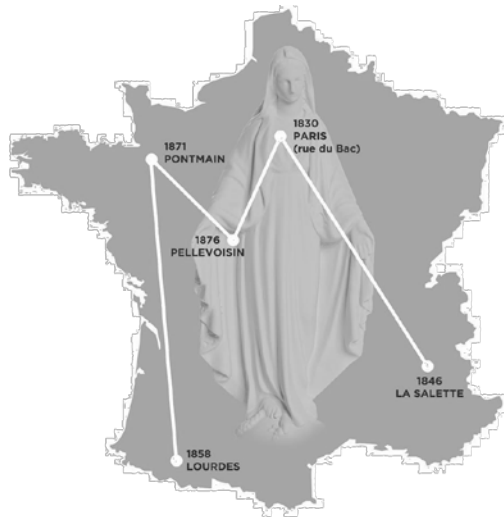

This 50th anniversary of the foundation of the Society of Saint Pius X by Archbishop Lefebvre will give us an opportunity to discover the historical heritage of France, the eldest daughter of the Church! Marked by 2,000 years of Christianity that heritage shaped its villages and traditions, France is full of cathedrals and shrines, witnesses of a rooted Faith! By consecrating France to Notre-Dame in 1638, King Louis XIII placed



his country under the protection of the Queen of Heaven.

This program offers you to travel from Notre-Dame de Lourdes to the seminary of Ecône, in the footsteps of Archbishop Lefebvre, discovering many sanctuaries and treasures of French and Swiss heritage!

D1 – Wednesday, October 21st

Flight to Paris, then Lourdes

Meeting at **Toronto** airport and departure to France.

Overnight flight.

D2 – Thursday, October 22nd

Arrival in Lourdes

Landing in **Paris-CDG** and transfer to **Orly airport**, then flight to **Lourdes**.

Welcome to **Lourdes** and transfer. Settling in your hotel and *Mass*.

Lunch not included. Dinner included. Settling and night in Lourdes.

D3 – Friday, October 23rd

Lourdes

Full day in **Lourdes**, largest French pilgrimage centre, following the apparitions of the Immaculate Conception to Bernadette Soubirous in February 1858. Visit of the dungeon of St. Bernadette, her childhood house and the parish church. *Mass*.

In the afternoon, free time. For those who wish, they will be able to take a bath in the 'pools' of miraculous water "Go to the spring, drink of it and wash yourself there".

Lunch and dinner included. Night in Lourdes.

D4 – Saturday, October 24th

Lourdes

In the morning, free time in **Lourdes**. Optional visit of the local market with regional products. Tasting.

In the afternoon, start of the official SSPX Pilgrimage in Lourdes.

Lunch and dinner included. Night in Lourdes.

D5 – Sunday, October 25th

Lourdes

Official SSPX Pilgrimage in **Lourdes**.

Lunch and dinner included. Night in Lourdes.

D6 – Monday, October 26th

Lourdes – Avignon

In the morning, end of the SSPX Pilgrimage in **Lourdes**.

In the afternoon, drive from Lourdes; stop by the city of Carcassonne surrounded by battlements and classified UNESCO heritage. Then drive through the Languedoc region and reach Avignon, the 'City of the Popes'. Settling at the hotel.

6 hours drive from Lourdes to Avignon.

Lunch not included. Dinner included. Settling and night in Avignon.

D7 – Tuesday, October 27th

Avignon – Notre-Dame de Sénanque – Notre-Dame du Laus

Visit first the historical center of **Avignon**, one of the few French cities with preserved ramparts in the historical center, which include the palace of the popes and surrounding areas, including the rock of the Doms and the bridge of Avignon. Avignon has been classified as World Heritage by UNESCO. Visit of the Palace of the Popes, then *Mass* in the SSPX Chapel in the old Avignon, near the famous bridge!

In the afternoon, visit of **Notre-Dame de Sénanque** abbey, founded in 1148 by Cistercian monks. Visit of the abbey church, the former dormitory, the cloister, the heating room and the chapter room, built in the 12th and 13th centuries.

Drive to **Notre-Dame du Laus** and settling near the shrine.

1h30 drive to Sénanque; 3h30 drive from Sénanque to Le Laus.

Lunch not included. Dinner included. Settling and night in Notre-Dame du Laus.

D8 – Wednesday, October 28th

Notre-Dame-du-Laus – La Salette – Notre-Dame-du-Laus

In the morning, travel to the **Marian sanctuary of La Salette**, where Our Lady appeared to two young shepherds on September 19th, 1846. The Blessed Virgin asked them to let the world know that if it persists in its impiety, the punishments

will be severe, if it becomes converted, it will obtain the Divine Mercy. She spoke against Sunday work. Visit of the basilica built on the place of the apparition, located 1800m above sea level. *Mass.*

Then, drive back to **Notre-Dame-du-Laus**. Between 1664 and 1718, a little shepherdess named Benoîte Rencurel had many apparitions, including the Virgin Mary, Christ on his Cross, Saint Joseph, the Child Jesus, the angels, the devil... Visit of the shrine with the Basilica, the Chapel of the Precious Blood and Benoite's House. After the visit, optional walk to the different apparition sites where chapels were built.

1h30 drive to La Salette.

Lunch not included. Dinner included. Night in Notre-Dame du Laus.

D9 – Thursday, October 29th

Notre-Dame-du-Laus – Chambéry – Ars-en-Formans

In the morning, we will hit the road to Ars. If enough time, we may take a detour to visit the city of Chambéry, the « City of the Dukes », capital city of the Savoy counts in the 13th century. The old town is composed with former Savoyard aristocracy's mansions.

Then reach **Ars** in the evening. Visit of Saint Jen-Marie Vianney's church. Thousands of sinners used to travel to Ars to confess their sins to that holy priest, who became more and more known, especially for his piety and the miracles attributed to him. In order to divert the growing veneration of these "pilgrims", he built a chapel for Saint Philomena in his church, to which he later attributed all the graces granted; he named her his "dear little saint". *Mass.*

5h drive from Le Laus to Ars (add at least one hour if detour through Chambéry).

Lunch not included. Dinner included. Settling and night near Ars.

D10 – Friday, October 30th

Ars-en-Formans – Fribourg

In the morning, travel to **Fribourg**, Switzerland. On the road, stop near Lake Geneva, the largest alpine lake in Central Europe and natural border between France and Switzerland.

In the evening, arrival to **Fribourg**. On October the 13th, in 1969, in **Fribourg**, the seminary of the Priestly Society of Saint Pius X opened. The following Sunday, Archbishop Marcel Lefebvre with his ten seminarians went for a pilgrimage to **Notre-Dame de Bourguillon**. Visit of the shrine and *Mass.*

4 hours drive from Ars to Fribourg.

Lunch not included. Dinner included. Settling and night in Fribourg.

D11 – Saturday, October 31st

Fribourg – Sion

Visit of **Fribourg**, a town which preserves a medieval ensemble unique in Europe with nearly two hundred buildings. Visit of the Cathedral Saint-Nicolas, patron saint of the city. Visit also of the oldest church, Notre-Dame Basilica, built in the late twelfth century. A few steps away, the Cordeliers church contains magnificent works of art, including some of the oldest stalls in Switzerland and valuable 15th and 16th century altarpieces. *Mass.*

At the end of the day, you will reach **Sion**, near **Ecône**.

2h drive from Fribourg to Sion.

Lunch not included. Dinner included. Settling and night in Sion.

D12 – Sunday, November 1st

Ecône : All Saints Day

All Saints Day at the SSPX international seminary in **Ecône**, funded by Archbishop Lefebvre. *Solemn Mass and Offices.*

In the afternoon, optional visit of **Sion**.

30 minutes drive from Ecône to Sion.

Lunch box and dinner included. Night in Sion.

D13 – Monday, November 2nd

Ecône : All Souls Day

All Souls Day at the SSPX international seminary in **Ecône**. *Solemn Mass*; meeting with the rector of the Seminary and visit to the tomb of Archbishop Lefebvre.

In the afternoon, visit **Saint Maurice** abbey, a notable place of Christianity in Europe. Then travel to **Geneva**.

30 minutes drive from Ecône to St. Maurice. 1h30 minutes drive from St. Maurice to Geneva.

Lunch box and dinner included. Settling and night in Geneva.

D14 – Tuesday, 3 November

Sion – Geneva – Return flight

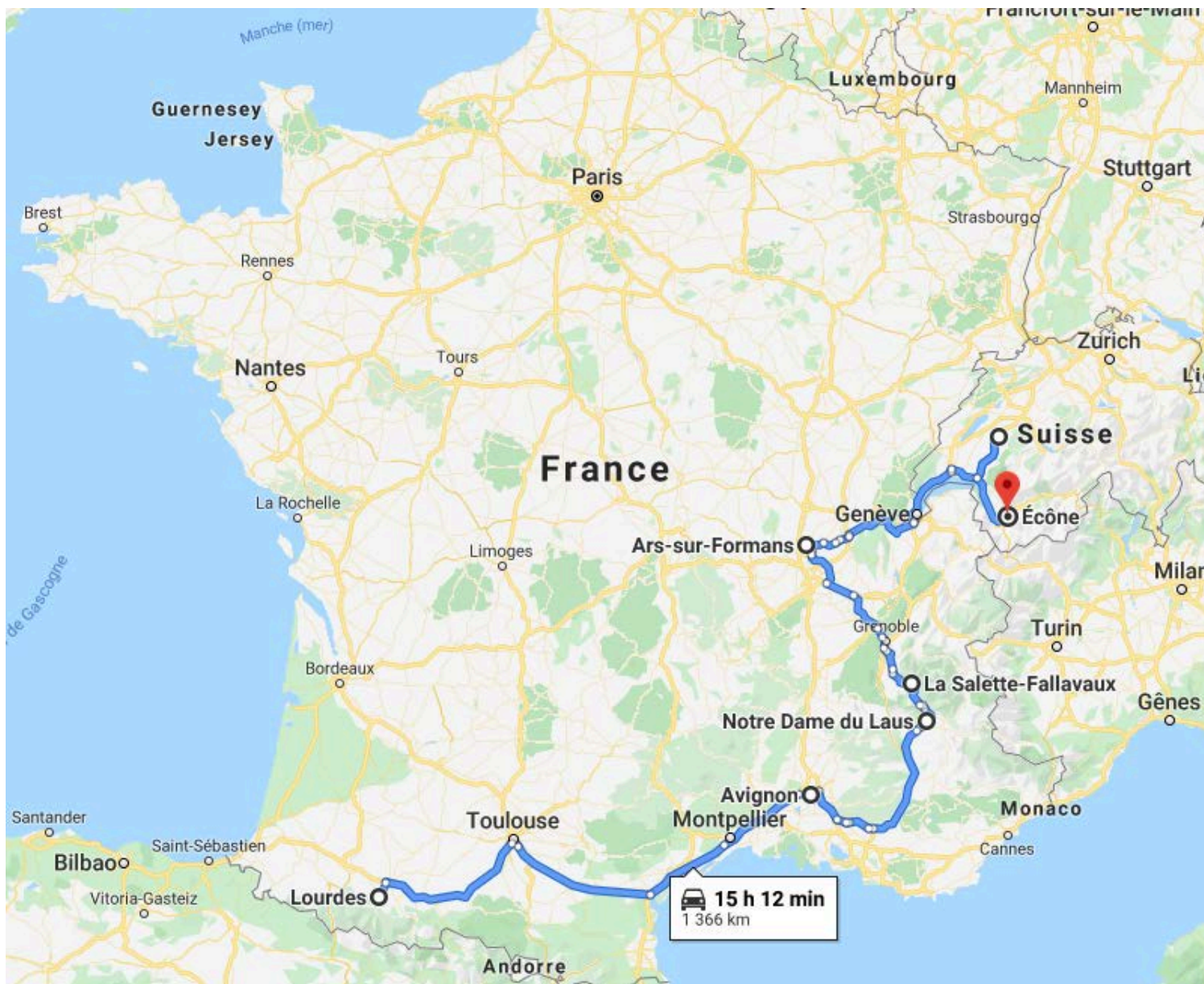
Transfer to **Geneva** airport and return flight to Canada.

Cancelling conditions:

In case of cancellation, the following costs per person who cancels will be retained:

Formalities

- Passport valid 6 months after the return date
- Additional formalities according to nationality

The name written on the registration form must be the same as your identity document.

Odeia declines all responsibility in case of mistaken the name and ID validity.

Note : The price is based on airport taxes. This price is therefore subject to change and may be revised one month before departure. The price is also based on a minimum of 30 paying participants; a surcharge may be applied if the group is less than 30 paying participants.

How to register?

- Fill out the registration form, and submit to Mrs. Barbara Acheampong, SSPX Ontario secretary in Toronto.
- For the deposit fee, you have the choice
 - Either you pay the deposit fee of \$400 with SSPX Ontario. Cheque payable to "Society of St. Pius X Ontario".
 - Or you may register directly with the Travel Agency in France, using your credit card, on their website.
 - In that case, you will have to comply with their request of 40% deposit.
- A penalty may be charged for those who register after Easter 2020.
- During the 1st Quarter of 2020, the travel agency will let notify us about be the deadline to pay the full amount.
- Tips: €40 (Cad\$60), to be collected on the day of the departure.
- Keep in mind that the Travel Agency is billing the SSPX Ontario in €.
 - So far, the exchange rate between the Cad\$ and € has been relatively stable over the past years.
 - However, in case of change in the exchange rates, an adjustment may be necessary either way.
- It should be possible to accommodate the pilgrims who want the "Land only" section of the pilgrimage. Make your request ASAP.

Further information from Alix, our travel agent:

- when the AM and PM is not specified, it is because it is too complicated to know precisely ahead of time.
- If the pilgrims register soon, it will be easier to guarantee the availability with the hotels... **I think most of the group should be registered by Easter the latest.**
- The seat selection will not be possible as it is a group contract. The pilgrims who want will be able to change the automatic seat selection will have to do so at the airport before departure.
- Concerning the deposit for the pilgrims, if you prefer to ask them less, there is no problem. You should know that registration on our website with credit card is 40% price deposit and we cannot change this. I suggest we open a page for those who want to pay by credit card with only the price of the air tickets and they pay the balance directly to you.
- I will open a page for you in order to illustrate what I mean and I will send you the link. If you want, you can see the FSSPX pages following this :
